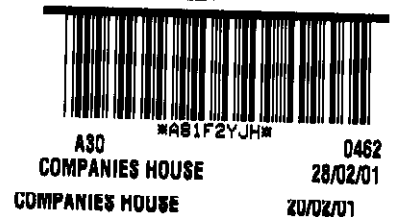

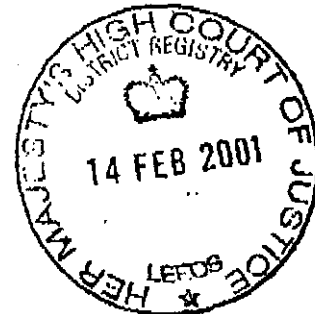

UPON the Petition of Trevor Bendrien, Willie Bendrien, Roger Lyndon Haigh, Edith Margaret Lusby and Arthur Smith, Directors of W & M Bendrien Limited ("the Company"), presented to the court on 13th February 2001

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Petitioners

AND UPON reading the evidence marked as having been read

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. During the period for which this order is in force the affairs, business and property of the Company be managed by the joint administrators hereinafter appointed pursuant to the provisions of section 8 of Insolvency Act 1986 for the following purposes:
  - (a) the survival of the Company, and the whole or any part of its undertaking; and/or
  - (b) a more advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be effected upon a winding up; and/or
  - (c) the approval of a company voluntary arrangement;

2. Angus Matthew Martin of 10-12 East Parade, Leeds, LS1 2AJ and William Kenneth Dawson of 201 Deansgate, Manchester, M60 2AT, both of Deloitte and Touche, be appointed as joint administrators of the Company;
3. Any act required or authorised to be done under any enactment may be done by either or both administrators acting jointly or alone;
4. The costs of the Petition and the report filed in support of this Petition be paid as expenses of the administration;
5. Time for service of the Petition on the Company, National Westminster Bank plc, and the proposed joint administrators be abridged.
