1. The purpose of this written resolution is to disapply pre-emption rights and to adopt new Articles of Association. If the resolution is a special resolution the requisite majority needed to pass the resolution is members representing not less than three-fourths of the total voting rights of eligible members. If the resolution is an Ordinary Resolution a simple majority is needed in order for the resolution to be passed.
