1 Progress of the liquidation in the previous twelve months

1.1 Payments to creditors

No claims were received during the period and no payments were made.

1.2 Realisation of assets

The Joint Liquidators are obliged to realise and get in the Companies' property and maximise realisations. Details of the realisations made are set out below, with information relating to dividends, if any, contained within Appendix B.

1.2.1 Intra-group debtors

The DOS showed inter-company debts of £1 as follows:-

All of these debts will be written off as the time costs incurred to distribute these amounts in-specie will greatly outweigh the sums realised. If there are any objections from directors / shareholders then please contact us as soon as possible.

These debts were the only assets in the liquidations and hence all asset realisations are complete.

1.3 Case specific matters

The Joint Liquidators have liaised with HM Revenue and Customs ('HMRC') throughout the period.

We have successfully confirmed with HMRC in writing that they have no outstanding matters or objections to the closure of the liquidations for Booth Roe Metals Limited, Booth Roe Stainless & Nickel Alloys Limited, Hooton Lodge Limited and Rotherham Stainless & Nickel Alloys Limited. There remains an outstanding matter to resolve for North Derbyshire Metal Products Limited which is discussed further at section 3.2 below.

1.4 Administration and planning

Certain aspects of the work that the Joint Liquidators undertake are derived from the underlying legal and regulatory framework for cases of this nature. This work, which does not usually result in any direct financial return to shareholders, is a necessary aspect of ensuring that the Joint Liquidators are complying with both of their legislative and best practice responsibilities and ensuring that the case is managed efficiently and effectively. It includes matters such as:

Statutory requirements

- Preparing, review and issuing a progress report to shareholders;
- Taxation matters, pre-appointment VAT & tax returns; and
- General taxation matters and clearance.

Case management matters

- Periodic case reviews, ongoing case planning and statutory duties;
- Maintaining and updating computerised case management records;
- Dealing with routine correspondence not attributable to other categories of work; and
- Maintenance of cashiering records and billing.

2 Distributions to shareholders

There were no distributions made in the reporting period. As detailed in section 1.2, there are not expected to be any in-specie distributions, nor are there are any cash funds to allow any cash distributions.

3 Details of what remains to be done and matters preventing closure

3.1 Assets remaining to be realised

There are no assets remaining to be realised.

3.2 Other outstanding matters

HMRC have notified the Joint Liquidators of an outstanding VAT matter on North Derbyshire Metal Products Limited. This has prevented the closure of the liquidation alongside the other group entities in liquidation. A formal complaint has been made to HMRC as we have been trying to resolve the outstanding issue since March 2023 with no success to date, despite frequent chasing.

The Joint Liquidators continue to push HMRC in order to resolve the issue, however, at present we are not able to estimate the timing of the closures.

4 Receipts and payments summary

We attach as Appendix B a summary of our receipts and payments for each of the Companies for the period from 7 December 2022 to 6 December 2023.

4.1 VAT basis

Receipts and payments are shown net of VAT, with any amount due to or from HM Revenue and Customs shown separately.

5 Joint Liquidators' remuneration, expenses and disbursements

5.1 Authority for remuneration

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration was approved on a time costs basis by the shareholders on 7 December 2021, however the remuneration and expenses are being paid by a third party. No details of remuneration are thus shown in the receipts and payments accounts.

5.2 Expenses and disbursements

A statement of the expenses incurred during the period is attached at Appendix C. This includes all expenses incurred by the Joint Liquidators in the period of the report, irrespective of whether they have been paid or not and may include estimated amounts where actual invoices have not been received.

As all expenses are being paid by a third party, no expenses are shown in the receipts and payments accounts.

6 Members' right to information and ability to challenge remuneration and expenses

In accordance with the provisions of the relevant legislation members have a right to request further information about remuneration or expenses and to challenge such remuneration or expenses.

A request for further information must be made in writing within 21 days of receipt of this report.

Members of the company with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company, or any members with the permission of the court, may apply to court that the remuneration charged, the basis fixed or expenses incurred by the liquidator are in all the circumstances excessive.

Any such challenge must be made no later than eight weeks after receipt of the report which first discloses the charging of remuneration or incurring of the expenses in question.
