ORDER

UPON the application of Matthew Waghorn, Louise Brittain, Anthony Cork and Stephen Grant ("The Application")

AND UPON reading the Witness Statement of Keith Aleric Stevens

AND UPON the Secretary of State having been given notice of the Application pursuant to rule 12.37(6) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 on 18 December 2018.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Each of the County Court cases listed in the Schedule of Appointments (attached to this order) be transferred to THE HIGH COURT OF JUSTICE BUSINESS AND PROPERTY COURTS OF ENGLAND AND WALES INSOLVENCY AND COMPANIES LIST (ChD) for the purpose only of making this order and the Applicants ensure that a sealed copy of this Order is lodged with the Court having jurisdiction over each case affected by the Order.
2. Immediately upon this order taking effect, the County Court cases listed in the Schedule of Appointments be transferred back to the County Court.

3. KEITH ALERIC STEVENS (**outgoing officeholder**) be removed from office in respect of each of the cases where listed in the Schedule of Appointments (**block transfer cases**) from the date of this order.
4. MATTHEW WAGHORN, LOUISE MARY BRITTAIN, ANTHONY CORK and STEPHEN PAUL GRANT (**replacement officeholders**) be appointed as replacement officeholders in respect of each of the block transfer cases where listed in the Schedule of Appointments from the date of this order.
5. The Applicants shall procure that, at the first convenient opportunity to do so, and in any event within 3 months of the date of this Order, a block advertisement in respect of each of the insolvency appointments listed in the Schedule of Appointments shall be placed in the London Gazette containing notification of the following matters:
 - 5.1. the removal of the outgoing officeholder and the replacement by the replacement officeholder, as the case may be;
 - 5.2. that creditors (and members in the case of Members' Voluntary Liquidations) and debtors have liberty to apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge this order;
 - 5.3. that creditors (and members in the case of Members' Voluntary Liquidations) and debtors have liberty to apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to object to the outgoing officeholders' release;
 - 5.4. that in the case of liquidations and bankruptcies listed in the Schedule of Appointments, the outgoing officeholder will be entitled to apply to the Secretary of State for his release upon the expiry of 42 days from the date the notice has been advertised, SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to one of the insolvency appointments has been made by a creditor, a member in the case of Members' Voluntary Liquidations, or a debtor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the outgoing officeholder will not seek to apply for his release in relation to that insolvency appointment until after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the court).
6. In relation to the Insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedule of Appointments, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 contain any requirement for advertisement of the removal of the outgoing officeholder or his substitution by the replacement office holders, compliance with paragraph 5 above shall be deemed as being sufficient compliance with any such advertisement provisions and for the avoidance of doubt, any further compliance with such notice provisions shall be waived. Insofar as the outgoing officeholder is required by law to give any notice of his removal from office, the replacement officeholders (and each of them) are entitled to sign and send any such notice on his behalf.
7. The period to be covered by progress reports to members and/or creditors and the dates by which those reports need to be sent to members and/or creditors and filed with the Registrar of Companies (if applicable) shall not be altered by virtue of the making of this Order or the replacement of the outgoing officeholder by the replacement officeholders, as the case may be, pursuant to this Order; and for the avoidance of doubt, any such requirement necessitating an alternation in the reporting dates by reason of the date of

commencement, termination or replacement of an office holder's appointment, are hereby waived.

8. The costs of and occasioned by the Application shall be paid by Wilkins Kennedy LLP
9. There be liberty to apply.
