#### 1 Accounting policies

#### 1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard N° 1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

#### 1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards except the directors have resolved not to comply with Financial Reporting Standard N° 8 "Related Party Disclosures".

#### 1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable in respect of rental income.

#### 1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets other than freehold land are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

#### 1.5 Foreign currency translation

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into euro at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. The total turnover of the company for the year has been derived from its principal activity wholly undertaken outside the United Kingdom.
