1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery

- 25% on reducing balance

Fixtures and fittings

- 25% on reducing balance

Stocks

Work in progress is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, as adjusted for the right to consideration.

Cost includes all direct expenditure and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Operating lease committments

Lease payments under operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

Pension commitments

Contributions by the company to the company's pension scheme are charged in the profit and loss account for the year they are paid.

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods and services, excluding value added tax.
