1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods and services, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery	- 25% on reducing balance
Fixtures and fittings	- 15% on reducing balance
Computer equipment	- 25% on reducing balance

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

4. ULTIMATE PARENT COMPANY

The ultimate parent company is Stormway Enterprises Limited.

5. RELATED PARTY DISCLOSURES

During the year the company purchased management services of £546,554 (2013: £406,000) from Stormway Enterprises Limited, the parent company, on normal commercial terms. The company paid dividends of £500,000 (2013: £300,000) to Stormway Enterprise Limited. Other Debtors include £465,071 (2013: £1,048,698) due to Stormway Enterprises Limited.

The company purchased goods to the value of £9,918 (2013: £33,501) from The Emily Todhunter Collection Limited which is a subsidiary of Stormway Enterprises Limited. The company also sold goods to the value of £418 (2013: £42,137) to the same company. All transactions were on normal commercial terms. At the balance sheet date, the amount due to The Emily Todhunter Collection Limited was £nil (2013: £325,030).

The company purchased management services of £75,000 (2013: £75,000) from Lyra Investments Ltd, a company whose sole director is the spouse of the director, E Olympitis. The transactions were carried out on terms which the directors consider to be normal commercial terms.

6. ULTIMATE CONTROLLING PARTY

There is no controlling party of the company with both the directors, Mrs K Hill and Mrs E Olympitis, having an equal holding in the parent company.

7. BANK OVERDRAFTS

Bank loans and overdrafts are secured by a fixed and floating charge over the company's assets.
