I enclose for your information an annual progress report in accordance with Rule 4 49B of the Insolvency Rules 1986 in respect of the Companies

The period of this report is from 1 August 2015 to 31 July 2016 ("the Period") I enclose two Receipts and Payments accounts for the Period showing a balance in hand for each of the Companies of £5,000, for your information

1) Receipts & Payments

During the reporting Period each there has been two receipts of £5,000 received in respect of each of the Companies Please see below, for further information.

2) Progress of the Liquidations

As previously reported, the Companies are associated with Claims Direct plc over which Malcolm Cohen and Robin Davis are also appointed as Joint Liquidators. A settlement agreement was entered into by Claims Direct plc in relation to a claim for potentially negligent advice. The settlement sum of £262,500 was received by Claims Direct plc in January 2016.



The Companies were also required to enter into the same agreement for which a settlement contribution of £5,000 per company was paid in order to cover costs

3) Future prospects

Claims Incorporated plc

We have been made aware of a potential insurance settlement due to CI, investigations into this matter are currently ongoing. Further details will be reported to creditors upon the conclusion of our investigation

There are no other further assets anticipated to be realised

Medical Legal Support Services Limited

There are no further assets anticipated to be realised

Upon finalisation of our investigation into the above mentioned insurance matter the Liquidations are expected to be closed

4) Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

Pursuant to the Insolvency Rules 1986, the Joint Liquidators are obliged to fix their remuneration in accordance with Rule 4 127(2) of the Insolvency Rules 1986. This permits remuneration to be fixed either.

- 1. as a percentage of the assets realised and distributed; and/or
- 2. by reference to the time the Joint Liquidators and their staff have spent attending to matters in the Liquidations, and/or
- 3. as a set amount, and/or
- 4 as a combination of the above

The enclosed schedules at Appendix B, summarise the time costs accrued by both BDO LLP and Carter Backer Winter in the Period and indicates the work undertaken in that respect. In this regard, I can advise that £4,300 has accrued in respect of MLSS and £7,206 has accrued in respect of CI

A summarised breakdown of each of the Joint Liquidators' time costs since appointment is enclosed at Appendix C. The enclosed schedules analyse the time costs accrued and indicates the work undertaken in that respect. In this regard, I can advise that in respect of MLSS this shows total accrued time costs to date of £11,099 which is comprised of 51 hours at an average hourly charge out rate of £216. In respect of CI this shows total accrued time costs to date of £15,175 which is comprised of 71 hours at an average hourly charge out rate of £213.

To date, the Joint Liquidators have not drawn any fees from either Liquidation

Should creditors consent, the Joint Liquidators intend to draw fees from the funds available in the Liquidation. Any outstanding time costs will be written off

5) Joint Liquidators' Disbursements

Where disbursements are recovered in respect of precise sums expended to third parties there is no necessity for these costs to be authorised. These are known as category 1 disbursements. The below table sets out the total category 1 disbursements outstanding in respect of the Companies.

Liquidators often charge expenses for example postage, stationery, photocopying charges, telephone and fax costs, which cannot economically be recorded in respect of a specific case BDO LLP operates a policy of raising an annual charge of £5 per creditor to recover the foregoing costs, which is paid from the Liquidation estates

Such expenses, which are apportioned to cases, require the approval of the creditors, before they can be drawn and these are known as category 2 disbursements. I can confirm that no charges of this nature have been drawn during the reporting period of the Companies.

6) Meeting By Correspondence

I propose that the fixing of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration basis be dealt with by vis. way of a postal vote pursuant to Rule 4 63A of the Insolvency Act 1986

Accordingly, I have enclosed a postal resolution form in respect of each of the Companies at Appendix D, for your completion and return by no later than 26 September 2016. In the event that Creditors whose debts amount to at least 10% of total debts of the Company would prefer for this vote to be conducted at a physical meeting, then you may request that a meeting be convened within 5 business days from the giving of this notice using the forms attached at Appendix E

7) Creditors' rights

I provide at the end of this report an extract from the insolvency Rules 1986 setting out the rights of creditors to request further information and/or challenge the remuneration or expenses within the Liquidations

Statement from the Insolvency Rules 1986 (as amended) regarding the rights of creditors in respect of the Joint Liquidators' fees and expenses:

Rule 4.49E Creditors' and members' request for further information

(1) If-

- (a) within the period mentioned in paragraph (2)-
 - (1) a secured creditor, or
 - (ii) an unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question), or
 - (iii) members of the company in a members' voluntary winding up with at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company, or
- (b) with the permission of the court upon an application made within the period mentioned in paragraph (2)-
 - (i) any unsecured creditor, or
 - (ii) any member of the company in a members' voluntary winding up,

makes a request in writing to the liquidator for further information about remuneration or expenses set out in a progress report in accordance with Rule 4 49B(1)(e) or (f) (including by virtue of Rule 4 49C(5)) or in a draft report under Rule 4 49D, the liquidator must, within 14 days of receipt of the request, comply with paragraph (3) except to the extent that the request is in respect of matter[s] in a draft report under Rule 4 49D or a progress report required by Rule 4 108 which (in either case) was previously included in a progress report not required by Rule 4 108

- (2) The period referred to in paragraph (1)(a) and (b) is-
 - (a) 7 business days of receipt (by the last of them in the case of an application by more than one member) of the progress report where it is required by Rule 4 108, and
 - (b) 21 days of receipt (by the last of them in the case of an application by more than one member) of the report or draft report in any other case
- (3) The liquidator complies with this paragraph by either-
 - (a) providing all of the information asked for, or
 - (b) so far as the liquidator considers that-
 - (1) the time or cost of preparation of the information would be excessive, or
 - (ii) disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the Liquidations or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or
 - (iii) the liquidator is subject to an obligation of confidentiality in respect of the information, giving reasons for not providing all of the information

Rule 4.131 Creditors' claim that remuneration is or other expenses are excessive

- (1) Any secured creditor, or any unsecured creditor with either the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the creditors (including that creditor) or the permission of the court, may apply to the court for one or more of the orders in paragraph (4)
- (1A) Application may be made on the grounds that-
 - (a) the remuneration charged by the liquidator,



- (b) the basis fixed for the liquidator's remuneration under Rule 4 127, or
- (c) expenses incurred by the liquidator,

is or are, in all the circumstances, excessive or, in the case of an application under sub-paragraph (b), inappropriate

- (1B) The application must, subject to any order of the court under Rule 4 49E(5), be made no later than 8 weeks (or, in a case falling within Rule 4 108, 4 weeks) after receipt by the applicant of the progress report, or the draft report under Rule 4 49D, which first reports the charging of the remuneration or the incurring of the expenses in question ("the relevant report")
- (2) The court may, if it thinks that no sufficient cause is shown for a reduction, dismiss the application, but it shall not do so unless the applicant has had an opportunity to attend the court for a hearing, of which he has been given at least 5 business days' notice but which is without notice to any other party

If the application is not dismissed under this paragraph, the court shall fix a venue for it to be heard, and give notice to the applicant accordingly

- (3) The applicant shall, at least 14 days before the hearing, send to the liquidator a notice stating the venue and accompanied by a copy of the application, and of any evidence which the applicant intends to adduce in support of it
- (4) If the court considers the application to be well-founded, it must make one or more of the following orders-
 - (a) an order reducing the amount of remuneration which the liquidator was entitled to charge,
 - (b) an order fixing the basis of remuneration at a reduced rate or amount,
 - (c) an order changing the basis of remuneration,
 - (d) an order that some or all of the remuneration or expenses in question be treated as not being expenses of the Liquidations,
 - (e) an order that the liquidator or the liquidator's personal representative pay to the company the amount of the excess of remuneration or expenses or such part of the excess as the court may specify,

and may make any other order that it thinks just, but an order under sub-paragraph (b) or (c) may be made only in respect of periods after the period covered by the relevant report

(5) Unless the court orders otherwise, the costs of the application shall be paid by the applicant, and are not payable as an expense of the Liquidations
