## Report of the Trustees for the year ended 30 March 2023

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 March 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

#### Objectives and aims

The purposes of Cheshire Carers Centre are:

- a) To alleviate the conditions of life amongst people who are caring or who have cared for elderly, sick, disabled, handicapped or otherwise infirm persons at home (hereinafter called 'carers') and who are in necessitous circumstances and dependents of carers who are themselves in necessitous circumstances.
- b) To relieve and alleviate, and to advance, promote, encourage and assist in the relief or alleviation of all kinds of mental and physical infirmity, sickness, disablement or handicap including mental illness attributable to caring amongst carers and those persons for whom they are caring.
- c) To advance education concerning caring amongst carers and the public.

The centre has a countrywide remit to provide information to carers across Cheshire and the incremental development of services is a key principle of Cheshire and Warrington Carers Centre. This development is dependent upon attracting additional resources. All services provided by Cheshire and Warrington Carers Centre are free of charge to carers.

#### **Public benefit**

The charity's trustees have complied with the duty in section 4 of the 2006 Act to have due regard to public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

#### ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

#### Charitable activities

After several years of pandemic impact, 2022/3 saw a return to more typical levels of activity across our services, with record numbers of carers making contact with us. As well as continuing to deliver a wide range of existing services, we also started to diversify our funding streams and develop new services to meet identified gaps and needs..

The main Cheshire West Carers Support Service had a further 12 month extension until September 2024, with the Carer Breaks services also extended to December 2023 to allow for a longer lead in time for new funding opportunites. This provides short/medium term security whilst we plan for and develop future funding bids.

A 9 month extension to March 2023 for the East Cheshire Carers Choice Awards including working carers, out of hours activities, relaxation sessions for carers and the further development of new breaks across the borough gave us time to secure ongoing funding for breaks until April / June 2024 through Lottery and Charitable Trusts.

In Cheshire East, the second year of delivering services under the Short Breaks for Disabled Children funding for families of children with additional needs, was highly successful for families across the borough. This will now continue until at least May 2024, albeit with reduced funding in place.

The Making Carers Count service, funded through Carers Trust for parent carers, celebrated its second year across Cheshire and Warrington with over 500 parent carers supported during the year. Based upon this work, we successfully bid through the NHS Transforming Care for Young People funding for a peer mentoring support service. This will match older children with young children to take part in activities to increase confidence whilst enjoying spending time together.

In Cheshire West and Chester we were fortunate to be chosen to help distribute funding for carers from The Government's Household Support Fund. This was able to support over 300 carers with funding towards essentials relating to food, fuel and other household needs. This vital funding attracted many new carers to our service for the first time and this important fund has now been extended for a further 12 months until March 2024.

As the year came to an end we were asked by Cheshire West and Chester to develop to a pilot project undertaking Carers Assessments on behalf of the Local Authority. This will involve seconding 2 of our current staff for an 18 month period to take on this important area of work.

## FINANCIAL REVIEW

## Financial position

The results for the year are shown in the Statement of Financial Activities.

Income for the year has increased to £933,466 with a rise in expenditure to £970,263. This results in net expenditure for the year of £36,797 and leaves funds at 30 March 2023 of £273,590, of which £135,237 are restricted.

#### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

#### Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

#### Organisational structure

The charity is a charitable company, limited by guarantee and was incorporated on 5th March 2001. It is governed by a memorandum and articles of association. The charity registered with the Charity Commission on 25th June 2002 and commenced its operations on 1st October 2002. The trustees are responsible for plotting the strategic direction of the charity and overseeing all areas of its operation. The day to day running of the charity is delegated to the paid staff.

#### Induction and training of new trustees

Trustees are appointed at general meetings in accordance with the memorandum and articles of association by approval of the existing trustees. The trustees for the period are as shown on page 1. In line with the memorandum and articles of association, at the annual general meeting, one third of the trustees will retire by rotation from office, but being eligible, may offer themselves for re-election.

## Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Cheshire and Warrington Carers Centre

Independent examiner's report to the trustees of Cheshire and Warrington Carers Centre ('the Company')

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of the Company for the year ended 30 March 2023.

## Responsibilities and basis of report

## Notes to the Financial Statements for the year ended 30 March 2023

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

#### Governance costs

Governance costs are those incurred in connection with the administration of the charity and compliance with constitutional and statutory requirements.

#### Intangible assets - database

The database has been amortised over it's estimated useful life of three years.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and fittings

- 15% on reducing balance

Computer equipment

- 33% on cost and 25% on reducing balance

### Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

#### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

## Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The charitable company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the charitable company's pension scheme are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.

### **Donated** goods

Donated professional services and donated facilities are recognised as income when the charity has control over the item, any conditions associated with the donated item have been met, the receipt of economic benefit from the use of the item by the charity is probable and that economic benefit can be measured reliably. On receipt, donated professional services and facilities result in the recognition of income and an expense.

No amount is included within the Financial Statements for volunteer time in line with the SORP (FRS 102).

## Grants paid

The charity welcomes applications for grant payments. Applications are reviewed by a panel consisting of management, staff and carers and awards are made based on the applicant's circumstances.

### Unrestricted funds

The general fund represents the free funds of the charity which are not designed for particular purposes.

The contingency fund consists of monies set aside by the trustees to mitigate risk. The contingency fund also covers any potential redundancy costs.

The Carers Centre Recognition fund represents monies designated by the trustees to match donations received and includes the monies previously held in the John Williams Memorial fund.

#### 18. MOVEMENT IN FUNDS - continued

The Development funds East, West and Warrington have been established from historical sources of funding which are no longer commissioned by either Cheshire East Council, Cheshire West and Chester Council or Central and Eastern Cheshire Primary Care Trust. These funds will be spent to support and develop new services for carers in each of the designated areas.

The Transport Fund represents monies to be used for future transport costs.

Household Support Fund - funding through Government to support food, fuel or other essentials.

NHS Legacy Research Funds -funding to study the impact of pandemic on carers and to look at effectiveness of solutions developed to offer support during this time.l

#### Restricted funds

Emergency card - funding to provide an emergency card for carers to use if they are unable to carer due to illness, accident etc. The card is linked to a contingency plan with emergency contacts who can take over the caring role. The service is currently in partnership with Wellbeing assistive Technology.

Warrington Fund - to cover our work in Warrington Borough - this work has been paused during the pandemic with a view to restart in 2021/22.

Parent Carer Support in Cheshire East - to enable Parents of children with additional needs to access breaks, information, training and mutual support.

Capital Grants Fund - this was provided to enable premises in Crewe and Northwich to be refurbished and equipped to better support carers.

Clocktower Café - provision of a community café in the Gateway in Warrington. Unfortunately, the café closed in October 2020 due to the pandemic.

Children in Need - funding to provide activities for families of children with additional needs during school holidays and weekends across both East and West Cheshire.

Read and Connect fund - providing opportunities for carers to come together to read and share their views on books, films etc. During the pandemic, the service went on line with a view to restart on a face to face basis during autumn 2021.

Carer Break Monitoring - An extension to the Carers contract to provide support and monitoring to the Better Care Funded breaks for carers. There are currently 10 providers across Cheshire West and Chester.

Carer Breaks funding for Third Parties - this is the funding we hold to provide the above Better Care Funded Breaks.

You Care You Choose - a breaks service provided under the Better Care Funding allowing carers to shape their own breaks services across Cheshire West and Chester.

Cheshire West Carers Support Service (CWCSS) - there are 6 elements of this service as listed. The funding for Third Parties includes the services we subcontract with The Alzheimer's Society. Making Space, The Bren Project, NMC, Opal and Crossroads Together. This service is delivered under a contract with Cheshire West and Chester Council until December 2022

Time for Me (East Carers) - funding awarded through the Carers Choice Programme to provide breaks for carers in Cheshire Fast

Arts Development Funding - offers small groups of carers with arts and crafts activities. Work is showcased across both Cheshire East and Cheshire West and Chester. The funding for this service comes from a variety of sources including Cheshire Community Foundation.

Covid 19 Support Fund - was awarded through the Lottery to help us to diversify our service offer during the pandemic including a weekly information blog, extended out of hours helpline and the distribution of ICT to carers which was provided by CWAC.

The Morgan Foundation - funding to support us with ICT and other equipment for enable home working for staff during the pandemic, as well as support carers with emergency support and assistance.

Time for Male Carers - funding awarded through the Carers Choice Programme to provide breaks for Male Carers in Cheshire East.

Time for Young Adult Carers - funding awarded through the Carers Choice Programme to provide breaks for Young Adult Carers aged 18 -25 in Cheshire East.

Mind the Gap (Courage to Care) - NHS funding to research the needs of carers in Armed Forces families.

East Breaks - combination of three projects through Carers Choice awards in Cheshire East to support working carers, offer complementary therapies and and new types of breaks.

Making Carers Count - funding from Carers Trust's Covid Support Grant to identify hard to reach carers. We will support Parent Carers of children with additional needs up to the age of 25.

LD Winter Pressures - through Cheshire and Merseyside ICB to provide support to Carers of Adults with Learning Disabilities and Autism. Funding can be used to reduce the likelihood of carer breakdown and hospital admissions.

CYP mentoring through the NHS Children and Young Peoples Fund to allow older children to support younger children to gain confidence and friendship through taking part in activities.

Carers Breaks for third parties - funded through Better Care Funding. 8 local organisations providing breaks for carers across Cheshire West and Chester.
