INTRODUCTION

We refer to our appointment as Joint Liquidators of the above on 17 September 2021 and hereby submit our final progress report regarding the administration of the liquidation in accordance with the Insolvency Act 1986 and Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016.

In support of this report we enclose:

- · Appendix A Liquidators' Receipt's and Payment's Account; and
- Appendix B Time and Chargeout Summaries (Liquidators' costs from 17/09/2021 to 23/01/2022; and
- Appendix B1 Time and Chargeout Summaries (Liquidators' costs from 24/01/2022 to 02/02/2023; and

We would now like to report to you generally as follows: -

The company was placed into creditors' voluntary liquidation on 17 September 2021. Brendan Doyle and Dean Collins both of Doyle Davies were appointed Joint Liquidators.

This is the final account and report of the joint-liquidators to creditors and members pursuant to section 106 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

The information provided in this report is to fulfil the requirements imposed on the liquidators under the Insolvency Act 1986 and the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 and is not to be relied upon by any party for any other purpose.

BACKGROUND

The company was incorporated on 7 June 2002 as Partspeed Limited and traded as a wholesale trade of motor vehicle parts and accessories. The Company traded from Unit 2 Forge Industrial Estate, Nantyfyllon, Maesteg, CF34 0AY.

The Directors convened a statutory meeting of the company's members, which was held on 17 September 2021. The members resolved to place the Company into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation and Brendan Doyle together with Dean Collins were appointed joint liquidators.

Following a Deemed Consent Procedure, it was resolved that Brendan Doyle and Dean Collins would continue to act as joint liquidators and no objections were received from the creditors.

ASSET REALISATIONS

There were no assets listed in the Statement of Affairs due to the Company's assets being sold prior to the Liquidation.

Contribution to Costs

The director made a contribution of £6,000 that went towards out pre-liquidation costs for placing the Company into Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation.

CREDITORS

Secured Creditors

There were no secured creditors during the Liquidation.

Preferential Creditors

There were no creditors in this category.

Secondary Preferential Creditor

It was anticipated that HM Revenue & Customs would have a claim in the region of £13,000. We did not receive a claim during the Liquidation.

Prescribed Part

Under the provisions of Section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986 the Liquidator must state the amount of funds available to unsecured creditors in respect of the prescribed part. This provision only applies when a company has granted a floating charge after 15th September 2003.

On the basis that there is no floating charge claim against the Company, there is no requirement to set aside a prescribed part for creditors.

Unsecured Creditors

The statement of affairs reported that there were 10 unsecured creditors totalling £789,055.38. During the Liquidation we received 11 claims from creditors totalling £768,223.17.

DIVIDENDS

There is no prospect of a dividend to any class of creditor in this matter.

LIQUIDATOR'S REMUNERATION AND DISBURSEMENTS

Following the Liquidator's appointment several resolutions were sought as follows: -

- 1. That a Liquidation Committee need not be established.
- 2. An initiating fee of £5,000 plus VAT in respect of the liquidator's work prior to the date of liquidation was approved.
- The basis and amount of the Liquidators fees and expenses as set out in the Estimated Fee Calculation totalling £14,980 plus VAT and £720 plus VAT respectively were approved.

We have incurred time costs of £8,099 plus VAT since the date of my appointment as per Appendix B and B1 attached. We have drawn a liquidators' fee in the sum of £782 plus VAT it being noted that there is a considerable shortfall to this practice.

During January 2022, as a practice, we changed our case management system so therefore our time recorded in administering this matter is recorded separately as per the Appendices attached.

Creditors and members have a right to request further information in respect of the liquidators' remuneration and expenses in accordance with Rule 18.9 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 and have the right to challenge the amounts drawn under Rule 18.34. Copies of these rules are available on request.

This firm does not charge category 2 disbursements to this case.

OTHER COSTS

It was agreed that an initiating fee of £5,000 plus VAT be paid to Doyle Davies, in respect of the firms cost of assisting the Director with the preparation of a statement of affairs and placing the company into creditors voluntary liquidation. These costs had been paid from the director's contribution to costs.

STATUTORY

The liquidators have complied with their obligations imposed by statute and their regulatory body.

INVESTIGATIONS

In accordance with statutory requirements, the liquidators have submitted a conduct report to the Insolvency Services Section of the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy pursuant to the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986.

The liquidators carried out an initial assessment of the areas where further investigation was required and concluded that no further action to be taken.

NOTICE OF FINAL ACCOUNT PRIOR TO DISSOLUTION

Pursuant to Rule 6.28 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016, notice is hereby given that:

- 1. The Company's affairs are fully wound up;
- 2. A creditor has the right to request information from the liquidator under Rule 18.9 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016;
- 3. Members and creditors have the right to challenge the joint-liquidators' remuneration and expenses under Rule 18.34 of the Rules;
- 4. A creditor may object to the release of the joint-liquidators by giving notice in writing to the liquidators before the end of the prescribed period.
- 5. The prescribed period is the period ending at the later of
 - i.eight weeks after delivery of the notice, or
 - ii.if any request for information under rule 18.9 or any application to court under that rule or rule 18.34 is made when that request or application is finally determined;
- The joint-liquidators will vacate office under section 171 on delivering to the registrar of companies the final account and notice saying whether any creditor has objected to their release; and
- 7. The joint-liquidators will be released under section 173(b) at the same time as vacating office unless any of the company's creditors objected to the liquidators' release.
