IT IS ORDERED THAT

- In respect of those Bankruptcies and the Compulsory Liquidation listed in the Schedules to this Application which are the subject of proceedings in County Courts, those proceedings be transferred to the High Court of Justice, Business and Property Courts in Bristol, Insolvency and Companies List (ChD) solely for the purpose of this Application and thereafter transferred back to the relevant County Court.
