In rural Cumbria, AWAZ has been working on community development since 2005 by providing support for formal/informal community groups and empowering the voice of BME people and communities (including migrant workers, Gypsy and Travellers and Refugees) and infleuncing policy that have an impact on communities.

AWAZ Cumbria have worked with partners on tackling Hate Crime, both supporting organisations who support communities but also with Victims and witnesses ensuring the issues are addressed by partners.

AWAZ Cumbria aims to create strong and vibrant BME communities, fully engaged in the decisions which affect their growth and development.

More recently our work has focussed on Community Integartion.
