

Audit Report

The company commenced operations with the opening of Trading Spaces, a retail outlet in Burgess Hill with an emphasis on supporting new start organisations which have an emphasis on sustainability, the environment and reduction in food waste. The company took a 3-year tenancy on an empty shop unit and refitted it to create four smaller unit which have been offered to tenants on terms that are not available in the commercial market.

Trading Spaces has benefited the community in the following ways:

- Local residents on low incomes have been able to buy their groceries at a newly formed charity, Burgess Hill Community Cupboard CIO that operates from one of the four units in Trading Spaces. This helps charity members make their incomes go further. The charity has circa 200 members and in total supports over 600 residents.
- Food is sourced for the charity from a variety of sources which includes arrangements with organisations and businesses that reduce the volume of food that would otherwise be sent to landfill.
- Trading Spaces also includes a social enterprise called Scrapless that operates on a zero-waste model as a refill store for food and household products. In addition to reducing waste sent to landfill, Scrapless is a base for recycling and sources many of its products locally to help reduce food miles.
- The four units provide employment opportunities for at least 4 people plus have created a volunteer network of up to 20 residents.

The company's stakeholders are residents of Burgess Hill and the tenants of Trading Spaces. There are regular meetings with the tenants who receive free business advice from the company.
