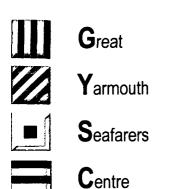

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### Treasurers Report 1st April 2019 - 31st March 2020

We ended the year with a net outgiving of £2554.91. This is because work on the refurbishment of the Bathroom area was just about completed with funds held over from the previous year.

The 50/50 draw brought in £765 profit, £35 down on the previous year. The number of players at present is 22 (it did reach 30 at one point) but we have lost numbers for various reasons. There was no income from N I M. The £50 a month stopped at the end of last year. A £1000 donation from Anglian Water because the centre had to close for a short period helped to support us to the end of the year.

The total received in Income in the year was £2915.00

Most of the payments went on the daily running of the centre and the refurbishing of the bathroom area.

The total amount in Payments in the year was £5469.91

This left us with a loss on the year of £2554.91

With the £3663.27 we started the year with, the amount carried into next year is £1108.36

I thank all our various donators for their contributions and also the Committee for all the assistance given to me over year and in producing these accounts.

I ask that they are approved and accepted.
