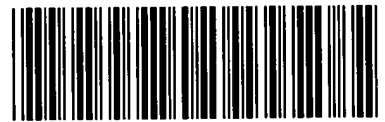

Further to our very pleasant stay with you at Shanklin I suggest there is a way of preparing the Summer House for remedial preservative action.

To get the best out of any works it would be best to do so after a long period of dry weather which is not a regular occurrence here in Blyth.

Therefore if it were possible to place some 4.5 metre 4 inch by 2 inch lengths of timber over the roof and fix tarpaulins to overhang the building this would create exactly the right sort of closed environment in which we could apply several coats of preservative to seal away the existing wood work.

Looking at the next ten days we have a sustained period of hot dry weather and if it could be done, this is exactly what is required.

If not hopefully there will be another opportunity later this summer.
