Company activities and impact

The Square Shop is the village store in the small Devon village of Northlew, opening in Feb 2020 with the aim of supplying local produce and products to local residents with any profits being fed back into the local community. The product range focuses is very much on locally produced and sourced items with a nominal carbon footprint and to this end we are currently supporting eight local businesses who provide us with free range eggs, milk, bread and cakes, meat, ice cream, superb quality vegetables and two cheese producers. We also stock goods from six local people including two types of honey, jars of preserves and bottled fruits, baked goods, cakes, handmade greeting cards and local wool which is naturally coloured and has not been dyed or chemically treated. One of the many positives of this approach has meant that throughout lockdown we have continued to receive supplies and could therefore support our remote community, remaining open throughout the whole year. It is not just a shop, but also acts as a social hub for local residents and offers. There is a prescription service from two surgeries. The Square Shop was awarded 'Covid Hero' status by West Devon Borough Council at the end of last year for our organisation skills, having been recommended by the Parish Council.

Consultation with stakeholders

Feedback is welcomed and actively encouraged and given from all our customers and local residents, with consultations being very much more informal but regular. During the course of our first year a number of additional products have been added following feedback, with our mode of operation changing and adopting in response to both the lockdown requirements but also our customer base needs. For example there is now cover outside the front of the shop and an area to display goods without having to enter.

Directors' remuneration
