## Report of the Executive Committee

The Executive Committee hereby submit their report, together with the Accounts for the year ended 31 March 2022.

#### Constitution and Registration

The Council is constituted as a Company limited by guarantee which is registered in Scotland (number SC97519) and is registered as a charity with Inland Revenue (Scotland) under reference CR41976.

#### **Objects and Activities**

The principal objects of the Council was the provision of a counselling and advisory service to those suffering from addiction related problems and to the members of their immediate families in the Moray area.

The Council ceased activities towards the end of 2015.

#### State of Affairs/Closure of the Service

The results for the year are disclosed in the Statement of Financial Activities. Sources of funding from Statutory Bodies, Moray Council and NHS Grampian, ceased some years ago and the Executive Committee came to the conclusion that there were no sustainable sources available to enable the provision of services to continue.

It was resolved that, the Company be wound up and the remaining funds be distributed to an appropriate Charity with similar objects in the local area. Application for consent to dissolve the Company has been granted by OSCR.

#### **Small Company Provisions**

This report has been prepared in accordance with the provisions for small companies contained in the Companies Act 2006.
