The company runs The Iris Arts CIC, a community cinema and theatre in Ayr with a particular emphasis on making arts accessible to all residents of South Ayrshire.

During the financial year 2020/21, The Iris' activities have benefitted the community in the following ways

- -residents of South Ayrshire have been able to consult with the company to shape the future of The Iris and to shape what they would like to see delivered on screen and on stage on their communities via our mobile cinema and film making and theatre production classes
- -3000 local resident have consulted with The Iris to give us their views on what they would like to see delivered by us in their community
- -The company has delivered cinema to 3500 people locally
- -The company has engaged with 400 young people locally in a creative writing project
- -The company has delivered Free cinema sessions to 500 people in the community
- -The company has engaged 562 young people locally to take part in community performance
- -The company has engaged with community learning and education to make 4 short films with young people locally
- -The company has engaged with 6 local primary schools to deliver creative workshops
- -The company has recruited 5 additional volunteers
- -The company has engaged, consulted with and delivered 4 rural location mobile cinemas
- The company has consulted with the community and delivered Ayrshire's first free online film festival
